STATE/TERRITORY SPECIFIC INFORMATION FOR MANDL ONLINE PROGRAMS

Students may view the disclosure for each program or certificate to know which state Mandl curriculum:

- meets NY state educational requirements for licensure or certification,
- does not meet NY state educational requirements for licensure or certification, or
- has not made a determination.

Mandl College cannot provide verification of an individual's ability to meet licensure or certification requirements unrelated to its educational programming. Such individual determinations are made by state licensing boards and are fact-specific determinations.
